Timothy J. Becker, DVM, diplomate ACVIM is a graduate of Tufts University School of Veterinary Medicine. After finishing his veterinary degree, he completed a one-year small animal rotating internship at Angell Memorial Animal Hospital in Boston, Massachusetts. Dr. Becker then worked in general practice in Maine for 2 years before starting an internal medicine residency. He completed a 3-year internal medicine residency program

at Michigan State University. Upon completion of his internal medicine residency, he joined the internal medicine service at a private practice referral center in Connecticut. In 2002, Dr. Becker joined the faculty at the University of Tennessee as an assistant professor of internal medicine. He completed a cardiology residency at the University of Tennessee in 2006. Dr. Becker joined the team of specialists at Oakland Veterinary Referral Services in 2008. Dr. Becker's research interests include cardiomyopathies, systemic arterial hypertension, pulmonary hypertension, feline hyperthyroidism, and he is skilled in both abdominal ultrasound and echocardiography. He is one of only a handful of diplomates board certified in both internal medicine and cardiology. Dr. Becker is the only veterinarian in Michigan double board certified in both of these subspecialties.

Dr. Becker is a member of the American Veterinary Medical Association, the American College of Veterinary Internal Medicine, and the Southeastern Michigan Veterinary Medical Association.
