Annette Petersen, Dr.med.vet. is board certified by the American College of Veterinary Dermatology. Dr. Petersen is a 1991 graduate of the College of Veterinary Medicine in Hannover, Germany. Dr. Petersen received her Dissertation in 1992 from the CVM in Hannover, Germany which is equivalent to a master degree in the United States. After graduation she moved to Washington and completed a 1 year rotating internship in small animal medicine and surgery at Washington State University. Upon completion of

her internship she began a 3 year residency in veterinary dermatology at Michigan State University. This training involved clinical dermatology and allergy as well as dermatohistopathology. Upon completion of her dermatology residency Dr. Petersen remained on staff as Assistant Professor in Veterinary Dermatology where she teaches senior veterinary students. Her special interests in clinical dermatology are autoimmune skin disease, treatment of Mycosis fungoides, chronic otitis externa (video otoscopy) and atopy.
