Dr. Jennifer Covey graduated with her DVM from Colorado State University in 2004. After completing a rotating internship in small animal medicine and surgery at VCA West Los Angeles where she was the 2005 Intern of the Year, she went on to perform a residency in small animal surgery at Michigan Veterinary Specialists. Dr. Covey then became board-certified by the American College of Veterinary Surgeons, also winning the ACVS Outstanding Surgical Resident Award in Research Publication for 2009. She completed a surgical oncology fellowship at the University of Florida College of Veterinary Medicine, one of only two programs in the country to offer this fellowship. She went on to become a clinical assistant professor at the University of Florida, after which she worked as an associate surgeon at Pittsburgh Veterinary Specialists and Emergency Center. Dr. Covey joined the team of surgeons at OVRS in November 2016.

Dr. Covey's areas of interest include: *oncologic and soft tissue surgeries*. She has published research in liver resection techniques, limb spare complications, and in bilateral adrenalectomy for the journal *Veterinary Surgery*.
